

Before the Game

 - Remember to have fun! Enjoy the day.

After the Game

- Thank the officials and the coaches for their effort
- Ask your child open-ended questions What was the most enjoyable part of the game for you? What was the least enjoyable? Do you feel you gave it your best effort? What did you learn from the game? Tell your child again that you are proud of them! (Especially if the game didn't go well)

Honors Volunteer of the Year In Memory of Wes Houseweart

In 1996, the Board of Directors of Lincoln Glen Little League inaugurated the "Volunteer of the Year" Award in loving memory of our last "old timer," Wes Houseweart, who passed away in November, 1995. This award is given each year to an individual who goes above and beyond the call of duty in volunteering his/her time to our league, as the success of our league is dependent upon the commitment and generosity of our volunteers, like Wes.

Wes Houseweart was one of our more legendary volunteers. Wes' loyalties to Lincoln Glen extended not only to actively participating as a coach, manager, board member and proud parent, but in cheering and watching all our children play baseball. Wes was one of the volunteers who would come back year after year to donate his time to our league (and tell his stories) even after his son, Randy Houseweart, and grandson, Robbie Thigpen, had graduated through our program.

Wes was also very active in maintaining and watering our fields. It was always a common sight to see Wes riding the tractor on the fields at all hours of the day! He would have been excited to see the new grass infield, even if it meant he would have to spend more time at the field riding around on the tractor. In 1997, we renamed our senior field the "Wes Houseweart" field in honor of Wes.

Justin McCarthy WES HOUSEWEART 2023 Lifetime Volunteer of the Year Award

"I did not plan to volunteer for LGLL. Baseball was not my area of expertise. My own Little League career ended at the age of 9. When my son wanted to play T-ball, I was super excited...to 'watch'. I played soccer as a kid and was already coaching my son's soccer team. I did end up helping with T-ball practices and was a team parent the next year, but, after his second year, my son was ready to give up on baseball. Fortunately an amazing coach/volunteer, Aaron Burriesci, made my son promise to give it one more year. That next year my son played on Aaron's team and Aaron asked me to be an assistant coach. After that year, both my son and I were hooked!

That third season, we both saw what a difference the right coach and the right attitude can do for a group of kids. I continued to coach and soon found my self on the board of LGLL, as well. I was fortunate enough to coach and manage for the rest of the time my son played Little League. The sport he was ready to quit when he was 7, became his passion and he played through high school. While baseball was not my area of expertise, I still managed to learn enough every year to keep myself a few steps ahead of the kids I was coaching and continued to work on the board of LGLL for several additional years supporting the league and the kids.

Volunteering through LGLL was a unique experience. I feel like the other parents were the ones that missed out. I got to have a blast teaching, training, motivating and having fun with their children in the afternoons and then send them home exhausted and hungry. It is one thing to see your kids play a sport from the bleachers, it is a completely different thing to be on the field with your kids playing that sport and participate with them. It was a lot of work, but I cherish every memory with all of the kids I was fortunate enough to coach.

I am honored to receive the Wes Houseweart Award this year. When I look at the other volunteers that have been given the award over the years, I am certainly not as worthy and am humbled to be in their rankings. When you read about Wes Houseweart in the annual LGLL program, they always show a photo of him on the tractor lawnmower. My nickname when I was coaching was "Tractor" because I loved driving the tractor, dragging the infield and mowing the grass. I would always jump at the opportunity to put a few miles on the tired old beast. I hope I made Wes proud.

If I can do it, you all can do it. And I highly recommend that you do. It was an amazing experience."

"Our family moved to the Willow Glen neighborhood of San Jose in 2013. With three young boys who all love sports, I knew my 'free time' was soon coming to an end. What I didn't know, and what I have learned in Lincoln Glen Little League, is that time spent volunteering has been much more valuable to my family and I then anything I could have planned before getting involved in Little League.

I started off 'helping out' in T-Ball, the way most dads do. Whether it was coaching a base or just making sure kids didn't hit each other with bats, I just wanted to help things run smoothly and assist where it was needed. As my sons grew older and came up through the Farm and Minors divisions, my duties morphed into Assistant Coaching, then Head Coaching, and eventually as a Board Member. 

Field Dedications

Sam Jones Field - Majors Division

-River Glen Park, dedicated March 27, 1993



In 1964 when Lincoln Glen was short on coaches, Samuel Edward Jones Sr. volunteered his services as a little league coach. For the next 29 years, Lincoln Glen would be a major part of his life. In addition to managing Lettermen, Sam was a member of the Board of Directors and handled everything from uniforms and equipment to dealing with the city and school district for field permits and improvements. For many people, both in our program and throughout the little league district, the name Sam Jones and Lincoln Glen Little League were synonymous.

To honor Sam and express our gratitude to his family for his years of service to this community, in 1992 the league requested and was granted permission by the City of San Jose to name the Major's Division Baseball Diamond after Sam. On March 27, 1993, the Sam Jones Field was dedicated with over a 1,000 Lincoln Glen players, parents and supporters in attendance.

When Sam Jones passed away in 1992, his family asked that donations be made to Lincoln Glen Little League in his memory. Sam's family generously earmarked those funds for a batting cage to be built adjacent to the Sam Jones Field at River Glen Park; Sam would have wanted these funds to be used to benefit as many baseball players as possible. The Sam Jones Batting Cage was built in 1998 and dedicated on opening day on March 20,1999.




Joe Walter - Farm Division

Not only was Joe Walter a founder of the league, but he also gave of his time and talents for well over 30 years.

Joe touched the lives and the hearts of literally thousands of Willow Glen neighborhood kids and their parents. In fact, many of us reading this tribute have not even lived as many years as Joe has spent volunteering with the Lincoln Glen Little League! It all began in the early 50's when Joe began coaching a pony-colt team for the League. When Joe's oldest son Robert turned 8 years old, there was no such thing as the LGLL Farm division. Joe decided there was a need for a separate league for 8 & 9 year-old kids because there was too much of a difference between the capability of an 8 year old and a 12 year old to play together. And so the Lincoln Glen Farm League was born... The emphasis would be on learning and sportsmanship, teamwork and fun; principles that still guide the Farm coaches and players today. Though he coached his team to victory during many games and seasons, winning was never the primary goal, it was just an outcome.

During his 33 years with the League, he served on the Board as the V.P. of Farm for much of that time, in addition to sponsoring and coaching the Mayfair Packing team each and every year. When his youngest son Barry was in college, Joe recruited him to help coach, and they were a great father and son coaching team for a few years, even coaching the Righetti brothers. Recently when Dave Righetti was inducted into the San Jose Sports Hall of Fame, it was Joe Walter that Mr. Righetti thanked and talked about before anyone else. That's the sort of influence that Joe had on the kids he coached. They remember him as a positive influence during their first experiences with baseball – a kind, gentle and patient man who would stop the game to help a player understand what happened and take that moment to teach them something big or small... A good leader who instructed and motivated each individual on the team in only the most positive ways, and at times even taught the parents a little about patience and encouragement!



Thank You To Our Past Presidents & Board of Directors

As we commence our 70th season at Lincoln Glen Little League, it is important for us to look back at the dedication and support of the numerous volunteers who have come before us and made Lincoln Glen Little League one of the premier little leagues in all of Santa Clara County.

It was back in the year of 1954 when Lincoln Glen Little League was founded. It was a time when Sports Illustrated published its first magazine and the New York Giants (now the San Francisco Giants) beat the Cleveland Indians in the World Series 4-0.

As a volunteer organization, the success of our league depends on the countless hours of all of our volunteers. From 1954 to 1971, Lincoln Glen Little League existed as an association, and in 1971 it was incorporated as a non-profit organization. It continues to this day to exist as a 501 (c)(3). In searching both programs and various archives, we have compiled a list of all of our past presidents for our Lincoln Glen Little League Board of Directors. We would like to thank these past presidents of our Board of Directors for their dedication to our league. This year we would like to pay tribute to the various leaders that have spearheaded these volunteer efforts.

As some of you may not know, Lincoln Glen Little League Women's Board was formed in 1965 by June Jones who felt a fundraising effort was necessary to provide the players with better uniforms and equipment. June and Mary Augilera began a Snack Shack at River Glen in an 8' x 8' metal utility shed. These two pioneers ran the Snack Shack at every game for the next two years. The first year, June and Mary boosted the league treasury with over \$600! The work of the Women's Board was instrumental in our publicity, merchant boosters, programs and running and staffing our two snack shacks.

In the year 2000, the Board of Directors decided to combine the two Boards and now we have nearly 25 individuals involved on our Board of Directors who handle all aspects of the league from mowing lawns to negotiating contracts with the City of San Jose for our use of the fields. For the most part, the work of the Board of Directors sometimes goes unheralded, but their dedication and support provides this league with valuable leadership and organization. Like many volunteer organizations, we are always in need of support both people wise and dollar wise. Lincoln Glen Little League is no exception. If you would like to donate your time, ideas or money, please contact our current president Tom Wilson.

Lincoln Glen Little League is lucky to have this very special Board of Directors. Thanks to all of you, past and present, from all of us at Lincoln Glen, and a special thank you to honor these past presidents who have presided over our Boards for the past 70 years.

What Parents Should Know About Little League Insurance

First, please remember that protective equipment cannot prevent all injuries a player might receive while participating in baseball. Injuries can and do occur and we want you to know what administrative procedures should be taken to file a claim.

The Little League Insurance Program is designed to afford protection to all participants at the most economical cost to the local league. It can be used to supplement other insurance carried under a family policy or provided by a parent's employer. If there is no other coverage, Little League Insurance (which is purchased by the League, not the parent) takes over and provides benefits for all covered injury treatment costs up to the stated maximums. This plan makes it possible for Little League to offer unmatched, low cost protection with the assurance to parents that adequate coverage is in force at all times during the season.

If your child sustains a covered injury while taking part in Little League Baseball, the following steps should be taken:

- I. File initial claim with insurance carried by family.
- 2. Should your family insurance plan not fully cover the injury treatment, the Little League Insurance Policy will help pay the difference up to the maximum stated benefits. This includes any deductibles or exclusions in your own insurance.
- 3. If your child is not covered by any family insurance, the Little League Insurance Policy becomes primary and will provide benefits for all covered injury treatment costs up to tile maximum of the policy.
- 4. Treatment of dental injuries can extend beyond the normal 52 week period if it must be delayed due to physiological changes of a growing child. Benefits will be paid at the time of treatment being given. even though it may be some years later. Maximum dollar benefit is \$500 for eligible deferred dental treatment after the normal 52 week period.
- 5. If you need to file a claim with Little League Insurance, contact Becky Jones. 408-354-1388 or rjones@grjlaw.com.
